 - 5.1.A. The District has no new Covid-19 cases.
 - **5.1.B.** The Southeast Water Main Replacement Project is behind schedule as a result of the delay in materials being delivered. The contractor is working diligently with suppliers to rush this process as much as possible.
 - **5.1.C.** The Elevated Water Tower Project was advertised for bid and 3 bids were received.
 - **5.1.D.** Since the last meeting, the District has installed 8 new residential water & sewer connections and 10 new sewer cleanouts, performed 4 water repairs and 1 sewer repair, and reset and mortared 5 sewer manhole castings.
