DIAMONDHEAD WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

April 14, 2022 – 4:00pm (CST)

City Council Chambers, 5000 Diamondhead Circle, Diamondhead, MS

1. PRESENT BOARD MEMBERS: Chairman John Kirschenbaum, Vice-Chairman Bryon Griffith, Treasurer Ben Taylor, Commissioner Mark Beisecker, and Commissioner Louis Ertel. ABSENT: None.

The presence of a quorum was noted and the meeting was called to order at 4:00pm. The public was duly notified in compliance with the District's open meeting policy.

2. Approve Agenda.

Motion by Commissioner Griffith, second by Commissioner Ertel to amend the agenda to add: (i) item 9.4 to discuss first draft of preamble to grant application; and (ii) item 9.5. Closed Session to discuss the need for Executive Session regarding potential litigation regarding a claim for damages at 67166 Diamondhead Drive East. Motion carried unanimously as amended.

3. Public Comments. None.

4. Minutes.

Motion by Commissioner Taylor, second by Commissioner Griffith to approve the minutes for the Regular Meeting held on March 24, 2022. Motion carried unanimously. (Attachment A).

5. General Manager's Report.

5.1. Update of Projects & Recent Events.

5.1.A. The Southeast Water Main Replacement Project is approximately 87% complete. The contractor is finalizing the open cut section on Lanai Street. The remaining items include a pressure test at Hilo Way/Maui Street intersection to complete paving work, 2 tie-ins, chlorination, and 1 fire hydrant installation.

5.1.B. The District has received the foundation drawings for the Elevated Water Tank Project. The drawings are currently under review. Piles for the tank foundation are expected to be delivered no later than the first week of May provided the materials are delivered as scheduled. The water line installations are expected to begin the week of April 18, 2022.

5.1.C. The contract for the Water System Improvements Phase II Project has been reviewed by legal and ready for signature.

5.1.D. On April 14, 2022, the Water System Improvements Phase III Project pre-construction meeting was held.

5.1.E. The Sanitary Sewer System Hydraulic Model Project is scheduled to be completed in early May. Model calibration deliverables are nearing completion.

5.1.F. On April 14, 2022, the Sewer Improvements Phase I&II Basins 13,16,17 Project preconstruction meeting was held.

5.1.G. Two abandonment of easement requests are on the agenda tonight. Both abandonment of easements are of no use either now or in the future to the District. Both are recommended for approval.

5.1.H. The District has installed 2 new residential water & sewer connections, 16 new sewer cleanouts, set 19 cleanout castings, and performed 6 water service repairs, 3 sewer service backups, and 5 sewer manhole repairs since the last Board Meeting.

5.1.I. The City of Diamondhead has yet to submit revised drawings of the proposed concrete storm water boxes on East Aloha Drive in proximity of the existing water mains to the District for review and approval. Failure to submit said drawings constitutes a violation of District Ordinances.

5.1.J. The variable frequency drive for Well#1 is expected to be delivered by April 18, 2022. Upon delivery, the contractor will schedule completion of the startup procedures for the new pump.

5.1.K. The temporary emergency pipe supports and culvert installed by the District at the Kolo Court drainage ditch are holding; however, the latest storms have exposed areas of concern. The temporary measures are an attempt to prevent sewer main damage from eroding ditch bank collapse while waiting for the City of Diamondhead to develop a drainage plan for the area.

Motion carried unanimously. (Attachment C).
