DIAMONDHEAD WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES June 8, 2023 – 4:00p.m.

1. PRESENT BOARD MEMBERS: Vice-Chairman Ben Taylor (chaired the meeting), Treasurer Louis Ertel, Commissioner Mark Beisecker, and Commissioner Arlen Griffey.

ABSENT: Chairman Bryon Griffith.

The presence of a quorum was noted, and the meeting was called to order at 4:03p.m. The public was duly notified in compliance with the District's meeting policy.

2. Agenda.

 - 4.1. <u>Motion by Commissioner Ertel, second by Commissioner Beisecker to approve the minutes for the Regular Meeting held on May 25, 2023. Motion carried unanimously. (Attachment A).</u>
- 5. General Manager's Report.
 - 5.1 Updates of Recent Events & Projects.
 - **5.1.A.** The crews are installing the concrete mow strip and fence for the Elevated Water Tower #2 Project. The painters arrived on site June 8, 2023 to disinfect and begin filling the tower. The contractor continues site cleanup.
 - **5.1.B.** The contractor for the Water System Improvement Phase II Project is working on various sites installing hot taps, cutting and capping, and tie-ins. The crews have begun to bring in the sod, and are scheduled to cut and cap along Koloa and Kahala. The road crew has begun preparing ahead of the asphalt sub-contractor.
 - **5.1.C.** The final pay app for the Water Tower #1 Exterior Painting Project is under review.
 - **5.1.D.** The Water System Improvement Phase III Project is approximately 83% complete. All HDD and open cut installations are complete. The 8" mains are 65% tested and active, and the 6" mains are 25% tested and active. Service connections are 30% complete and fire hydrants are 95% complete. Crews are scheduled to pave, install hot taps and tie into existing Phase I construction at Hilo Way and Maui Street. Paving is underway on Diamondhead Drive East.

- **5.1.E.** The Sewer Improvements Basins 13, 16 & 17 Project is approximately 53% complete. The contractor has completed the last point repair and video of the completed replacement sections at Golf Club Drive. The paving crew is scheduled to begin paving on June 12, 2023.
- **5.1.F.** The District has performed 5 after-hours water leak investigations, 4 water service repairs, 2 sewer service backups, 1 after-hours sewer investigation, 2 sewer lateral repairs, installed 6 sewer cleanouts and 2 new residential water/sewer connections, since the last meeting.
- **5.1.G.** The temporary emergency pipe support and culvert installed by the District at the Kolo Court drainage ditch are holding steady and the culvert is working. The temporary measures are an attempt to prevent further sewer main damage from an eroding ditch bank collapse. Pickering Engineering has developed drawings for a construction project to address this drainage area and are approximately 90% complete.
